In 2010 Queen Rania Hospital started to be one-of-a-kind hospital in Jordan as highly pediatric specialized referral hospital with 200 beds. Regarding the gastroenterology department initially led by three consultants. with a specifically designed 14 bed facility providing a pediatric gastroenterology regional service to Jordan with a catchment population of approximately 10 million. In addition, it attracts extensive superregional referrals and a significant number of foreign referrals are also seen.

The brief scope of service:

A) upper and lower GI endoscopy diagnostic and therapeutic service, and interventional endoscopy (currently comprising two lists a week) .

B ) coordinate and where necessary supervise a wide range of gastroenterological investigations including pH monitoring, upper and lower GI motility studies, and hydrogen breath tests ,

C ) perform regular audit of the unit's activity;

D ) spend daily sessions morning report in general pediatric and rounds for in patient genral pediatric and pediatric gastroenterology patients and two pediatric gastroenterology clinics per week.
