I am a Thoracic Surgeon. I'm capable of running the thoracic surgery clinic at my hospital, and managing the in- patients. I have great experience in team work and multidisplinary meeting organizing and participation. High spirit and enthuseastic.

I can perform major lung resections (Lobectomy, pneumonectomy, transpericardial pneumonectomy) in addition to other lung procedures weather by VATS(minimally invasive) or open. and can do major esophageal surgeries such as Transhiatal Esophagectomy, Ivor -Lewis Esophagectomy for esophageal malignancies, also I performed with my team few cases of minimal invasive esophageogastrectomy for early esophageal tumors. Also I can do diagnostic

procedures such as mediastinoscopy, rigid bronchoscopy and diagnostic thoracoscopy, and open and VATS decortication, pleurodesis, open and VATS pleurectomy, open and VATS excision of pleural based masses.

Also I can do trans-sternal and minimal invasive thymectomy for myasthenia gravis, resection of thymic tumours, VATS Thymectomy for early Thymomas, VAT biopsy mediastinal masses, VATS sympathectomy, VATS biopsy of mediastinal lymph nodes, open & VATS excision of bronchogenic cysts, open and VATS excision of posterior mediastinal tumors and neurogenic tumors.

I can do correction surgeries of pectus deformities (Ravitch), excision of chest wall tumors. I'm capable of managing acute emergencies such as blunt and penetrating injuries (low velocity and high velocity missiles) to the chest.
